Emergency Response Vehicle (ERV) Driver

The ERV is a standardized Red Cross disaster vehicle which supports mass care, mobile feeding, and fixed sight feeding requirements. Must be able to lift 50 pounds, take a drivers test, and complete 16 hours of training. This person is on call 24 hours/day for one week per month.

Armed Forces Emergency Services Caseworker (AFES)

This person is responsible for servicing military emergency communication requests. You must commit to at least one night every two weeks and will be on call from 4:45 pm to 9:00 am the following day. The position requires knowledge of Red Cross Service to military families policy and procedures and the ability to work with people in crises. You will be providing kind, courteous informed service to all clients.

Disaster Action Team Member (DAT)

DAT members are the main line of defense and the first responders to all single family fires within the county. DAT members are organized to place trained Red Cross volunteers at the scene of a disaster within minutes of its occurrence, to provide immediate, identifiable emergency services to disaster victims and emergency workers. In addition to initiating Red Cross relief actions, the team paves the way for mobilizing other chapter and national sector resources that may be required. DAT members are on call 24 hours/day for seven days approximately every third week. You must attend 16 hours of training classes.

Community Education Presenter (CDE)

The CDE presenter has the responsibility of speaking to school groups, and community organizations on the topics of the Red Cross "Masters of Disasters" and Community Disaster Education programs, working directly with Disaster Services and CDE coordinator.

CPR Instructor

Must possess a current Fundamentals of Instructor Training certificate, have current American Red Cross First Aid\CPR\AED Instructor authorization including thorough knowledge of first aid\CPR\AED skills. Instructors are needed throughout the year usually to teach evening or Saturday classes. We can arrange for you to teach when it best fits your schedule.

First Aid Instructor

Must possess a current Instructor Candidate Training certificate, have current American Red Cross First Aid and CPR Instructor authorization including thorough knowledge of First Aid\CPR\AED skills.
